Taieri River - suitable for kayaks (not supplied by camp) Rock and Pillar Range - DOC walking tracks - Range from short walks to overnight tramp to DOC hut. Macraes Gold Mine, ¾ hour drive away. Miners' Cottages - relics of gold mining era. *(These are on private property but permission to visit is readily given)* Central Otago Rail Trail - cycle or walks parts of this very well known scenic trail, it begins 8 km from the Camp at Middlemarch.
